- 5) The Book of Ezekiel – The Teacher is Bro. Mervyn Gobin (Assistant Preacher at the Sophia Church of Christ.


2nd year Students (2020 – 2022)

- 1) **Devon Emanuel** from the Melanie Church of Christ, Guyana.
- 2) **Reynolds Samuel** from the Kuru Kururu Church of Christ, Guyana – (Part Time Student) only attends the Wednesdays morning class. The school is desperately searching for someone who can sponsor him full time so he can attend classes fulltime. Has a very willing heart to study the word of God.



3) **Sharmin January** from the Kuru Kururu Church of Christ, Guyana – (Full Time Student) The school is presently assisting this student with \$80 US per month to travel from Kuru Kururu to Sophia and return. This Sister is married, having two daughters, both children are going to primary schools in Guyana. The school is desperately searching for a church or an individual to assist for two years at \$330 US per month. This will greatly assist her as a means of support for her family as she endeavors herself to attend school Bible



4) **Curtesha Cort** also from the Kuru Kururu Church of Christ, Guyana – (Full Time Student) The school is presently assisting this student with \$80 US per month to travel from Kuru Kururu to Sophia and return. This Sister is not married, and the school is desperately searching for a church or an individual to assist for two years at \$230 US per month. This will greatly assist her as a means of support for herself as she endeavors herself to attend school Bible.



5) **Angelia Emmanuel** from the Melanie Church of Christ is also a part time student. She is a school Teacher in training. Presently she studies online on Mondays.

The Georgetown School of Preaching and Biblical Studies, Guyana will soon complete its first two years. Each student that will be graduating on Friday, January 2023 will be completing 37 Bible Courses, taught by well qualified Teachers that have years of experiences in the mission field and teaching and preaching.

In Guyana, there is a real struggle to attract faithful men and women who would decide to attend Preaching school for two years and because of this some of our churches in Guyana are shrinking heavily in membership.

Leadership cannot be developed if Preachers and Leaders are not properly equipped to serve – by knowing the word of God. It's a blessing to invest into the lives of these students! The Lord's church is going to be equipped with strong Leaders – when training takes place.

We must thank God for what we have!


In the picture (which I was taken) some of the church members also in the picture visited the family and encouraged them to start attending the Kuru Kururu Church of Christ.
