AS AN ENCOURAGEMENT FROM THE PREACHER**

The Bible is the inspired word of God. It allows us to understand what God is like and what He is not like. The Bible reveals that God is, (1) The Most High God (Genesis 14:20), (2) The Almighty God (Genesis 17:1) and (3) The Everlasting God. (Genesis 21:33) Another amazing quality of God is His generosity in giving to people. “Every good gift and every perfect gift is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights, with whom is no variableness, neither shadow of turning.” (James 1:17)

Let us be like God and find ways to be liberal givers. “But the liberal deviseth liberal things; and by liberal things shall he stand.” (Isaiah 32:8) God repays with great increase anything that we give with a godly heart. It was out of His love that God gave his Son to save us from our sins. “For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whosoever believeth in him should not perish, but have everlasting life.” (John 3:16) God is a giver, and there is no worthier goal in life than to give like God gives.

(Ecclesiastes 11:1-2) You may trust your own wisdom and think your future is certain and sure, but adversity may come. Your world may be shaken in a way that you could never imagine. We can rest assured that when we obey God in the matter of giving and sharing, He will give back to us more abundantly. Be willing to help others even if it means sacrificing something that is precious to you. Share your blessing with others; pass on what God has given to you. This action will make it possible for God to bless you in your time of need.







TEACHERS, EVANGELIST, AND LEADERS TRAINING MISSIONS KICKS OFF FOR 2024
